For the family-run company OBO Bettermann – a leading manufacturer of installation systems for the electro-technical equipment of buildings and plants – the acquisition, including the production facilities, means sustainable expansion of their important cable routing systems product unit.

OBO is strengthening its core competence and market relevance,” explains company head Ulrich Bettermann. Both parties have agreed not to disclose any information about the purchase price.
